

# BRWF BREAKAWAY FUTURITY & DERBY RULES

Bonus Race World Finals Futurity & Derby Breakaway events are open to ALL ROPERS (men, women, any age).

Futurity & Derby are open to registered horses ONLY. A copy of the registration paper must be included with the futurity nomination form. NOTE: Futurity & Derby checks will be made to the owner listed on the papers. A copy of the signed transfer must be included if you are in the middle of transferring a horse. ANY BREED HORSE IS ELIGIBLE. THIS IS NOT A BREEDER'S PROGRAM. IT IS OPEN TO ALL REGISTERED HORSES.

**DATES June 14-19, 2022, Shawnee, Ok Heart Of Oklahoma Expo Centre (ROPING WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE OUTDOOR ARENA IN FRONT OF THE GRANDSTANDS) SAME LOCATION AS THE IFYR.**

**Times are tentative subject to change until official schedule is posted. DAY will not change.**

Derby 1<sup>st</sup> go 9 am sat June 18

Futurity 1<sup>st</sup> go will follow Derby Sat June 18

Derby 2<sup>nd</sup> go 11 am Sun June 19

Futurity 2<sup>nd</sup> go will follow Derby Sun June 19

**FUTURITY** – any horse 5 or under. Foaled 2017 or later First year of competition in breakaway roping.

**DERBY/MATURITY** – any horse 8 or under. Foaled 2014 or later (not futurity eligible – meaning you cannot enter BOTH the futurity and the derby). HORSE is eligible to compete until reaching 9 years of age.

## **Entry Fees**

**\$5000 added money to Futurity / \$5000 added money to Derby**

\$450 for 2D Futurity (1.5 sec split) 80% payout of entry fee and 100% added money. All checks will be mailed ONE WEEK following the event (make sure the owner has a w9 on file) Awards will be given at the event (no awards will be mailed).

Every roper pays a 1x office fee for the entire roping \$30 **Entries open Feb 15, 2022**

**Mar 15 deadline for \$330 nomination fee (or pay in full by this date) limited to first 100 received.**

**ADD \$50 LATE FEE FOR ANY HORSE NOT NOMINATED BY MAR 15, 2022**

**April 15 deadline for \$150 final payment and stall fee if a stall is needed (stall is not included)**

**AFTER APRIL 15 ADD \$100 LATE FEE. FINAL DAY TO ENTER IS MAY 15, 2022 OR SOONER IF ENTRY LIMIT OF 100 IS MET.**

**ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRIES AFTER MAR 15, 2022**

Stalls for this events are sold by the week, not by the night, however, for the futurity and derby, we will reserve 100 stalls (max) for nightly rental, but these MUST be paid in full by April 15 with your final payment. After April 15 this will NOT be an option. No refunds for any reason. Horse substitutions allowed with a \$50 substitution fee. Substitutions must be done at the event and a copy of the registration papers must be presented as well as a substitution form signed by the original owner. (\$40/night or \$100/week) **ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS OVERNIGHT MUST STALL. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. RV should be reserved through the Shawnee Expo Centre (details will be announced in April)**

This will be a separate roping (you cannot roll these times to other roping events at the BRWF). All Futurity & Derby entries will be given 2 calves. Payout will be 2 gos and an average. The go rounds will be 2D 1.5 sec split and the average will be STRAIGHT payback (paying more places) see projected payouts on the website (based on 100 entries in each).

## **Roping Format**

2 Rounds & Average, Average determines champions. Round 2 will be reverse order

Times will be taken to the hundredths. ex. 2.55

## **Barrier**

A rope barrier and electric eye will be used. All score lengths will be subject to BRWF roping committee's approval.

Two Timekeepers, a Field Judge, a Barrier Judge, and Spotter will be in the arena at all times. It is the roper's responsibility to make sure the flagger is in place and flag is up before nodding for calf.

## General Rules

**Contestants should check in at the trade show welcome booth upon arrival to pick up their welcome bag. A w9 form should be completed at check in (if not already mailed in) in the name of the owner for futurity/derby entries and in the name of the rider for all other entries. Negative coggins are required for all horses and health papers (within last 30 days) are required for all out of state horses. Draw order will be posted on [sgpevents.net](http://sgpevents.net) and stall assignments will be posted on**

Full western dress is required by contestant to be inside the arena. Long sleeved shirt, western hat, and western boots.

Futurity & Derby horses MUST be checked in and numbered prior to competition (time tba) approximately 2 hours prior to competition in round one. Failure to check in will result in a automatic disqualification.

Bell Collar Catch only. Bell collar catch is defined as any loop passing over the calf's head and slack is drawn around neck only. No other appendages of calf (i.e. front leg, tail, etc.) can be in loop when rope breaks from saddle horn. The rope must be drawn up around the neck with no extremities in the loop and in front of the tail head when string breaks. If any extremities are in the loop when the string breaks but then goes back around the neck of the calf it shall be a "no time".

Ropes must be tied to the saddle horn of contestant's saddle with nylon string at the VERY end of the rope. A cloth no shorter than six inches (6") must be tied to the end of the rope. String will be provided. Judge will check your rope to make sure it is tied on securely and properly as you check in at the holding area.

Only one (1) loop can be carried. A dropped loop counts as a contestant's thrown loop.

Rope must be released from contestants' hand to qualify for catch.

Contestant must pass thru barrier before loop is released. Contestant must be horseback when clock is stopped.

It is at the judges' discretion to give a rerun.

30 second time limit will be enforced. The arena outgate will remain open in the arena at all times. Time must be taken with calf in arena. If any part of calf has entered out gate, no time will be awarded.

Breaking the barrier will result in a 10 sec penalty.

The Field Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.

No time will incur if contestant breaks rope by hand or touches rope or string after catch is completed. Exception to above, is if rope dallies around the saddle horn. Contestant can ride forward to un-dally and then stop to allow rope to breakaway.

Contestant MUST BE in the designated waiting area (next to the BOX) when they are 2 away or they may be disqualified. Example: roper #1 is in the box, if you are roper #2 or #3 you MUST BE in the designated waiting area once that roper is in the box and check in with official. Failure to meet this deadline may result in disqualification. If roper does not meet waiting area check in deadlines, they may be given an automatic "no time".

Any horse that is unruly in the box and breaks the barrier once pulled more than 2x will be disqualified and forfeit their run. After 2x roper will be asked to leave the box and the calf will be turned out resulting in a "no time".

Any rules not specifically covered in this document are at the discretion of the roping committee.

## Stock Rules

\*Calves will be a chute run. Contestants must rope in drawn order. Nobody but hired help is allowed in the calf SORTING area. Anyone found manipulating the draw in any matter will be disqualified without refund. A contestant may have their own pusher.

\* No stock with horns will be used.
