THEME: THE AMAZING RACE

Who is eligible for entry at this event? While the Succeed Bonus Race (\$40,000+ added) requires the rider to have won a qualifier id# at an event held between Jan 1, 2025 - Dec 31, 2025 (special exception to those that won qualifiers in Jan 2026 due to EHV1 outbreak), to make an entry. It requires a DIFFERENT qualifier id# for EVERY run you make in this race. The Open 5D Jackpot (\$10,000 added) is open to the world. The Ultimate Bonus (Hi Stakes Package) includes 2 Bonus Qualifiers (that did not have to be won in 2025, they are given to you with this package) and 2 Ultimate Bonus sidepot entries with those runs. The entries are taken ONLINE ONLY and payment is required when you make your entry. We open the entries in phases giving those who purchased the Ultimate Bonus package (and have already paid in full) first chance to enter their horses in the system, select their sessions, etc. Followed by contestants with a 2026 Bonus Qualifier Id# and their immediate family (we appreciate you putting immediate family under the same user name on sgp so all entries are together, in our system).

How much does it cost? The Succeed 5D Bonus Race is \$130/run, The Open Jackpot is \$90/run. The office fee is \$35/rider (1x fee per rider) Stalls are limited, and \$150 for the week (good 4 pm Mon – end of show Sun) Please only purchase stalls for horses entered in the event. If you need to be stalled together it is BEST to have ONE USER purchase stalls. (max of 10 per user) FMI on the Ultimate Bonus Hi Stakes Package please see the guidelines and payment schedule. \$10 from every entry fee goes to the daily payout and is paidback 100%. \$5 from each open jackpot entry and \$10 from each bonus entry go towards the awards fees. OVER \$40,000 ADDED MONEY! Plus \$5000 Ultimate Bonus

NOTE – YOU CANNOT ROLL YOUR TIME FROM THE OPEN JACKPOT TO THE BONUS RACE – SEPARATE RACES!

OPEN 5D JACKPOT \$10,000 ADDED \$90 ef per run. A horse may run 2x max over the week in THIS race. (no roll overs) A rider can enter an u-unlimited number of times as long a horse does not make more than 2 runs in the OPEN JACKPOT. Sidepot: BRIF \$5000 added -no additional entry fee for BRIF enrolled horses – your FIRST run in the OPEN is the only run that will count towards BRIF. (please sign up at show office) youth, adult, senior 5D. \$40 ef. TOP 10 FROM EACH DIV, EACH SESSION (EACH DAY) WILL EARN BONUS RACE QUALIFIERS FOR 2026 FINALS. THESE CAN BE USED TO ADD ONTO any session OF THE BONUS RACE (AS LONG AS HORSE WILL NOT MAKE MORE THAN 2 RUNS IN THE BONUS RACE OVER THE WEEK). ON SITE FEE \$140 TO ADD ON. How do I know if I won a Bonus Qualifier ID# in 2025 (FOR 2026 FINALS)? We have a list of qualifiers for this year's finals on our website if for any reason you believe your name should have been on this list (you won a qualifier Jan 1-Dec 31, 2025) (note due to EHV1 outbreak at the end of 2025, we also counted Jan 2026) please email bbbarelbash@yahoo.com

What if I have multiple qualifiers but only one horse? A horse may run 2x MAX in the Bonus Race. This includes any combination of riders. Absolutely no more than 2 runs. It may also run 2x MAX in the open jackpot. Unfortunately, qualifier id # cannot be transferred to another rider nor sold. They must be used by the name of the rider they were issued to. We do not track horse names, only riders are associated with Bonus Race Qualifier Id#.

How do I choose which day I run? Choosing which day you run is very popular with our contestants! The tentative schedule for the week, has been posted on the website. Each day has BOTH an open jackpot session (am) and a bonus race session to choose from (except Sun please see schedule) with limited entries. Each race (open jackpot AND bonus race) are ONE BIG JACKPOT OVER multiple days. When the last open jackpot session runs on SAT we will have the full combined results (if you ran your horse twice, you will have a chance to win TWO checks). The Bonus race will conclude on Sunday. **There are no short gos – you pick and choose when you want your runs to be.** Sessions are limited, and as such entries are taken online only so that the computer can track how many available spots remain in each session. Once full it will not allow you to choose that session to enter. A horse may run twice in one day (once in the open jackpot and once in the bonus race), except Sunday, since only one session is offered on that day. NOTE KEEP IN MIND, YOU MUST HAVE A UNIQUE ID # FOR EACH AND EVERY ENTRY YOU MAKE IN THE BONUS RACE. **IF YOU WISH TO RUN 2X YOU MUST HAVE two DIFFERENT ID NUMBERS.**

What is the daily payout? The daily payout is \$10 from every entry fee and is paid out 100% in the session you run in on a 5D ½ sec split format. Each "session" champion will also receive a buckle. 5 buckles given in each session. That includes 10 Tues, 10 Wed, 10 Thur, 10 Fri, 10 Sat, 5 Sun. While the daily payouts are not big, they give MULTIPLE contestants a chance to win a check. These payouts are paid ON SITE in the show office and will be available at the start of the next session FOLLOWING the session you won your check in.

When is the open jackpot and bonus race paid out and awards presented? The open jackpot race will conclude on Saturday. All COMBINED OPEN JACKPOT CHECKS WILL BE MAILED THE WEEK FOLLOWING THE EVENT AS LONG AS YOU HAVE A 2025 W9 ON FILE. **OPEN RACE: Awards for the open race will be presented Sunday morning 15 min prior to the start of the Bonus Race. Division champions should be present to receive their saddles.** If you are not present, you must have someone stand in for a photo and pickup your award. We will not ship awards. The Bonus Race will conclude after the last run-on SUNDAY. **BONUS RACE: Awards are given to the TOP 10 in each division. We will not ship any awards. You must be present to receive your award or have someone available to accept the award for you and stand in for a photo.** In case of a tie for any awards, THE FASTEST TIME RAN IN THAT RACE ON THE 2ND RUN WILL BE THE TIE BREAKER, if each contestant only made one run in the bonus race on the horse tied, the contestants will roll dice. If there is a tie and a contestant themselves is not present, we will automatically award the tie to the contestant that is present **themselves**. All COMBINED OPEN BONUS CHECKS WILL BE MAILED THE WEEK FOLLOWING THE EVENT, AS LONG AS YOU HAVE A 2026 W9 ON FILE. W9 FORMS MUST INCLUDE SOCIAL SECURITY # OF RIDER (REGARDLESS OF AGE) AND ADDRESS, LEGAL NAME AND SIGNATURE/DATE.

***12 & Under Showcase** (For contestants 12 & Under as of Jan 1, 2026) Paid on a 4D ½ sec split. Five Star Producers will be allowed to SEND ONE contestant FREE. A mail in entry form will be sent to Five Star Producers to enter their 12 & Under representative. Entry fee \$60. Buckles to champions and awards through 3rd each div. \$3000 added. NOTE A SADDLE WAS DONATED FOR THE FASTEST TIME (ONLY 1D for 2026) FULL AWARDS 1ST-4TH EACH DIV PRESENTED APPROXIMATELY 1 HOUR AFTER RACE IN CONFERENCE CENTER.

REFUND/VET RELEASES/RIDER/HORSE SUBS: There will be NO REFUND or Vet/Medical releases allowed for any reason after deadline. The last day to get a refund will be May 17. This will be a partial refund only. The office fee, credit card fees, and 10% of each entry fee will be held. A rider substitution may be made in the show office only with a \$10 fee only if new rider is already entered in the finals on another horse and must ride same horse in that draw position and a rider may only be changed with a DOCTOR'S RELEASE. \$5 change fee is required. (NOTE A HORSE and RIDER CHANGE IS NOT ALLOWED) **SELLING SPOTS IS NOT ALLOWED.** A horse substitution fee may be made in the show office with a \$5 fee. **Changes must be made 30 minutes prior to the start of the session they are drawn in. These cannot be done via email, text, etc. they MUST BE done at the show office. NOTE**

– RIDER CHANGE MUST INCLUDE DOCTOR'S RELEASE AND ORIGINAL RIDER CANNOT COMPETE ON ANY OTHER HORSE ONCE CHANGE IS MADE. **Failure to make a proper horse change could result in disqualification.**

WHERE DO I ENTER AND WHEN? Online through our entry system. www.sgpevents.net Entries must be paid when you enter them in the system. Unpaid entries will be DELETED daily if not paid so that you do not take up space in a class or hold stalls that others want and are willing to pay for. Please do NOT make entries in the system until you are ready to pay. MAKE SURE YOU CAN ACCESS YOUR SGP ACCOUNT BEFORE YOUR ENTRY PHASE OPENS!

PHASE 1 PRE ENTRIES (tentatively) OPEN ONLINE May 6, 12 pm cst (FOR THOSE WITH THE ULTIMATE BONUS PACKAGE ONLY!) Close May 7.

PHASE 2 PRE ENTRIES (tentatively) OPEN ONLINE May 8, 12 pm cst (for those with the a Bonus Qualifier id# and their immediate family) Close May 10

PHASE 3 PRE ENTRIES WILL (tentatively) OPEN ONLINE May 11 OPEN TO THE WORLD (open jackpot entries only) Close May 17

PRE ENTRIES WILL CLOSE May 17, 2026 12 pm cst THE FINAL DAY TO REQUEST A REFUND IS May 17, 2026 final day to pre-enter without late fee

PHASE 4 May 18, 12 pm cst LAST CHANCE RE-ENTRIES TO FILL SPOTS OPENED UP FROM REFUND REQUESTS. THESE WILL HAVE A \$25 LATE FEE PER RIDER ADDED ONTO ANY CLASS OR ENTRY THEY ADD DURING THIS PHASE (NO EXCEPTIONS) Close May 19

No on site entries will be taken .The only other exception are those contestants qualifying on site in the open jackpot (top 10 in 1d-5d in their session) and adding onto the Bonus Race session of their choice. These entries may only be made during OFFICE HOURS 8 am – 7:30 pm

HOW DO I MAKE A SPECIAL REQUEST? With a show of over 3,000 entries, we do not take special requests. We have divided up the entire week for you to enter with the people you haul with. The draw is random, and we will not move you to another session. You must run in the session and position drawn. If you need to stall together you must have one person purchase the stalls on their account to ensure you are together. When you type the riders name in the stall box if you have a stallion or a kicker simply type the rider's name and stallion or kicker after that so we can TRY to accommodate you with an end stall.

BASIC RULES

***Dress code** -Full western dress (any long-sleeved shirt), (short sleeved shirt acceptable as long as it has a collar and short sleeves not sleeveless) western hat or helmet, western boots. Failure to follow dress code will result in a no time. (shirt sleeves should be rolled down and no ¾ length shirts please). **If you lose your hat in the arena it is a \$5 fine payable to the barrel setter to get it back.** ANY LONG-SLEEVED SHIRT IS ALLOWED AS LONG AS SLEEVES GO TO WRIST.

***Western tack** (including a western type saddle) is required. No rider will be allowed to compete bareback. A western saddle must be used.

***Hold pen** – riders must check in the hold pen with the gate official AND be inside hold pen before the tractors park and the gate shuts. Once the tractors stop the gate official will shut the gate, and it will not re-open. It is YOUR responsibility to know your draw number for each session and get yourself in the pen before the gate shuts. If you need assistance, ask the gate official or the "hold pen caller" in the back. The back gate will not open and shut once the drag begins. **If you do not make it inside before the gate shuts** you will be a no time. A 3-call rule will be enforced if a rider cannot get their horse down the alleyway it will be the announcer's discretion to scratch the individual. Once a 2nd call is given a time will be set and if rider is not down the alleyway in 60 sec after 2nd call they will be disqualified. A horse must run in the position drawn, running the wrong horse in the wrong position will result in a no time. No switching of draw positions. No moving draw positions. NO TRADING DRAW POSITIONS. Failure to make a change in the show office 30 min prior to the session beginning will result in a no time. It is your responsibility to get to the gate and be on time. **We WILL NOT move you to the end, we WILL NOT move you to another session for any reason.** If a horse is deemed "unsafe" in the hold pen it will be the gate official's discretion to remove them from the hold pen. The safety of other riders is our priority. We prefer NOT to have helpers "on foot" in the hold pen (you can bring in a helper horse). If you DO NEED to help someone in the pen please sign release form at "caller's booth" outside of arena and enter at your own risk. We ask that you be mindful of other contestants in the hold pen and stay out of the way of horses entering and exiting the gate.

***Forward Motion Rule** – once the rider reaches the end of the alleyway (plane of the arena) no circling is allowed. They must keep a forward motion once passing the "plane" of the alley. (no circling or turning around after end of alley) Failure to follow this rule will result in a disqualification.

***Race Formats** all races are 5D half sec splits

***Timer malfunction** – in case of a timer malfunction the rider will be given the option of a re-run. (PRIOR PENALTIES WILL APPLY)

***PENALTIES** A barrel down will be entered as a no time. A broken pattern will also be a no time. A rider that breaks the pattern and circles a barrel more than 1x may be fined \$50. Please do not circle more than once out of respect to the riders that follow you.

***No tolerance rule** will be enforced for excessive whipping, jerking, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, etc. Please remember this is a public event and will be webcast. We will not tolerate any excessive abuse to an animal. Failure to follow this rule may result in a fine of up to \$50. A no tolerance rule will also be in effect for contestants arguing with gate officials or show management. A fine of up to \$50 may be assessed in addition to Gate official's decision will be final.

***Number of times a horse can compete.** A HORSE MAY RUN 4X MAX AT THIS EVENT (SEE BELOW)

Open jackpot – maximum of 2 x between Tues and Sat

Bonus jackpot – maximum of 2x between Tues and Sun

2 riders may ride the same horse, as long as said horse does NOT compete more than 2x in either race over the course of the week. excluding the poles, and youth showcase! (no sharing of horses in the over and under showcase!

***PHOTOGRAPHER:** We have an official photographer for our event. No other photographs will be allowed inside the arena. Anyone besides the official photographer, found taking photos or posting on social media taken inside the competition arena may be fined up to \$500 and contestant may be disqualified, and winnings/awards forfeited. Anyone found taking photos will be asked to leave. The official photographer for this event is fesslerphotography.net PLEASE RESPECT OUR PHOTOGRAPHER. By entering, Double B Productions, LLC reserves the right to use your photo in social media posts and other promotions.

***WEBCAST WILL BE FREE** – a link will be posted on bonusracefinals.com our hope is to have an air conditioned viewing area with a big screen in the tradeshow area.

STALLS: TIE OUTS NOT ALLOWED. All horses on grounds OVERNIGHT must stall. DAILY JUMP OUT LOT WILL BE POSTED FOR THOSE NOT STALLING. OUTDOOR PENS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE (THEY ARE FOR STAFF ONLY) See office for availability in case we have any open up for availability. Stalls will open 4 PM MON, and are good through the end of the show Sunday. Stalls DO NOT include shavings. Shavings may be ordered in advance ON SGP UNDER "EXTRA FEES" DEADLINE IS MAY 14. Do not tie horses to trees.

ABSOLUTELY no horses are allowed to be tied in the warmup arena. ANY RIDERS SELLING/SHARING STALLS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL DETAILS RELATED TO SELLING/SHARING. DOUBLE B PRODUCTIONS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ISSUES RELATED TO SELLING/SHARING STALLS WITH OTHERS. **MAKE SURE THE USER ON SGP THAT BUSY STALLS BUYS SHAVINGS DO NOT BUY THOSE UNDER ANOTHER ACCOUNT PLEASE! STALL FEES VARY FROM \$150 FOR THE WEEK (feel free to share stalls – those agreements are between you and the original purchaser)**

WARM UP ARENA: There will be a small indoor warm up arena in the small barn and multiple outdoor arenas. Please do not use the indoor warm up until you are within 25 of your run.

CHECKING IN: All contestants must visit the show office upon arrival to pick up your "goodie bag" and complete a w9 form and make sure your account is paid. It is the responsibility of each contestant to make sure they have coggins for each horse and out of state horses should have 30-day health papers. Any contestant that fails to bring an animal on the grounds without the proper paperwork will be responsible for any penalties and fines that may be assessed by the state vet for the absence of said papers. OFFICE WILL BE OPEN 8 AM – 8 PM DAILY in the CONFERENCE CENTER.

RIDE AROUND SESSIONS \$10 each No barrels just limited open arena time (for 50 riders per session) Only chance to get in arena – arena will NOT be open for riding any other time.

Anyone found riding in the arena outside of designated ride session times will be disqualified. (limited # available) No refunds. If you miss your session, there will be no refunds given. please see schedule WE WILL NOT MOVE YOU FROM ONE SESSION TO ANOTHER. PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

***SCHOLARSHIP FORMS** – will be posted on bonusracefinals.com and should be turned in no later than Sat 12 noon (at show office) for contestants only.

***PBRIP** SIDEPOUT TO THE OPEN RACE ONLY! 5D \$2000 minimum added – \$75 ef per run (\$10/run to PBRIP) one big race Tues-Sat OPEN JACKPOT RUNS ONLY!

***W9 FORMS** – included in your show packet – ALL RIDERS – REGARDLESS OF AGE need their own social security number to receive winnings – come prepared. DAILY PAYOUTS ARE PAID AT THE START OF THE NEXT SESSION – ALL OTHER CHECKS WILL BE MAILED ONE WEEK FOLLOWING THE END OF THE EVENT.

ULTIMATE BONUS SIDEPOUT (HI STAKES). Max # of UB packages available is 250. Payout will be based on total # of packages sold. Each contestant that purchased a package will have TWO times in the final UB results (one from each Bonus Run). They will OPT INTO their Ultimate Bonus sidepot when they make their Bonus Race entries in the SGP entry system. Payout is 5D ½ sec split. Results will be announced FOLLOWING the Sunday Bonus Session. Checks will be mailed 1 week following the event. Rider must have 2026 w9 on file to receive winnings. ULTIMATE BONUS ENTRANTS MUST FOLLOW RULES SET FORTH IN THE CONTRACT AGREEMENT.

ANY RULES NOT COVERED HERE WILL BE RULED BY SHOW MANAGER RENEAE BEECH BOLLING AND BE FINAL. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY. PARKING A map will be posted with parking for daily jumpouts (those without stalls) Failure to follow parking guidelines, and parking barn next to the barn will be a \$500 fine and grounds for disqualification. There will be NO TOLERANCE for parking outside of the barn unless you are in an RV spot.

Stalling Notes

Less than 600 stalls available. A mixture of indoor dirt and cement \$150 outside pens are for STAFF ONLY they are here 12-14 days – no exceptions!

Please bring a manure cart, fork and dump manure in the appropriate containers. DO NOT PUT TRASH IN THE CONTAINERS! IT IS A BIG FINE!

We suggest bringing an extra extension cord (make sure it is in good working condition) if you plan to hang a fan. Stalls are 10x10
